

ABOUT THE CONFERENCE:

The Co-sponsors, inFIRE - the international network for Fire Information and Reference Exchange and the UK Fire Information Group, are information exchange co-operatives in the fire and loss prevention fields. These consortia of fire and related fire industry libraries and information centers include information managers, professional librarians, information officers, researchers and other interested parties and specialists involved in the acquisition and dissemination of fire information worldwide.

2nd International Fire Information Conference

This conference will once again bring together information professionals from around the world to provide a forum for sharing the most recent information in fire research and technology. The conference begins with visits and tours and concludes with papers and presentations that cover a wide variety of topics. Last September's terrorist attack in the USA has affected every segment of the fire community. The Fire Information Services community has also felt the affects of September 11th. While this conference will not focus on the event, discussions and tours will include the many organizations that have been affected.

The first three days of the conference will be dedicated to tours and visits. This will permit the UK members to reduce conference time, as they may be familiar with these UK institutions.

Conference Costs

The conference cost for the two-day conference on Thursday and Friday is £150 British Sterling or \$225 dollars US. The optional tour on Monday is £35 British Sterling or \$50 dollars US for transportation costs.


Accompanying Persons

Hotel Accommodations

The Conference will be held at the Imperial Hotel Russell Square, London. The hotel overlooks Russell Square Gardens and is a short walk from the British Museum, Theatreland, Covent Garden, Piccadilly Circus and the City and Law Courts. There are six Imperial Hotels (Imperial is the Conference Center Hotel) and these are operated by the same company and can be reviewed at: www.imperialhotels.co.uk

Wednesday May 29, 2002 - Tour the London Fire and Emergency Services and London Fire Brigade Museum.
