What is inFIRE?

inFIRE - the international network for Fire Information and Reference Exchange - is a worldwide consortium of libraries with significant collections of fire literature. Program activities include inFIRE conferences (open to members and non-members alike) which feature aspects of information access for fire professionals. Membership is open to organizations involved in fire research and testing, postsecondary fire education and training, fire and emergency services, fire protection consulting, fire insurance, and fire associations. Membership is granted to an organization's library or information center, not to individuals. Members must be able to loan full-text documents to other inFIRE members (normally free of charge) and must circulate at least one Accessions list per year to inFIRE members.

Benefits of inFIRE Membership

- Subscription to accessions lists provided by other inFIRE members
- E-document delivery at no cost.
- Access to fire library services around the world.
- Reduced or waived interlibrary loan fees
- Access to the inFIRE listserv, including asking reference questions on the inFIRE listserv.

- Sharing electronic copies of articles through interlibrary loans.
- Ability to access the accession list.
- Professional networking opportunities.
- Sharing new additions to collection, highlighting innovative members.
