What is inFIRE?

inFIRE - the international network for Fire Information and Reference Exchange - is a worldwide consortium of libraries with significant collections of fire literature. Program activities include inFIRE conferences (open to members and non-members alike) which feature aspects of information access for fire professionals.

Membership is open to organizations involved in fire research and testing, post-secondary fire education and training, fire and emergency services, fire protection consulting, fire insurance, and fire associations.

Membership is granted to an organization's library or information center, not to individuals. Members must be able to loan full-text documents to other inFIRE members (normally free of charge) and must circulate at least one Accessions list per year to inFIRE members.

To join inFIRE

Prospective members must submit a combined application form and library profile. The inFIRE executive committee reviews applications and elects organizations for inFIRE membership.
